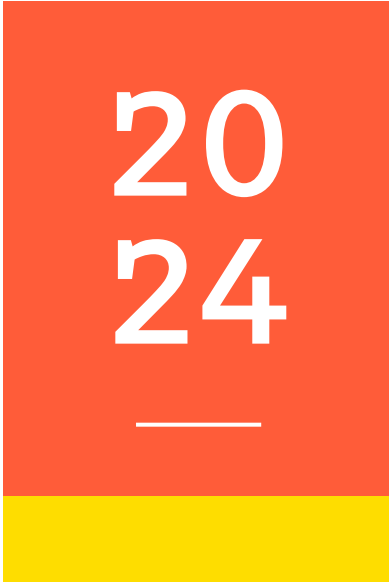

Education

TD Power Systems Limited (TDPS) is committed to social responsibility, focusing on education, community well-being, and environmental conservation.

Recognizing this importance, the Company allocates resources to education projects, including sustainable infrastructure in government schools using renewable energy, early childhood education, and providing remedial support for children with learning difficulties.

This investment aims to empower the education sector and contribute to environmental conservation, paving the way for a brighter future for all.

Project 1: Rooftop Solar PV System

The Company is dedicated to providing uninterrupted learning while addressing climate change and sustainability. TDPS installed Solar Rooftop Systems at four government schools, with three located in Bangalore featuring 5KVA off-grid systems and one in Udupi district, Karnataka, equipped with an 11-kilowatt off-grid system.

Partnering with Trinity Care Foundation facilitated these installations at a total cost of Rs. 22.72 lakhs. These efforts have reduced reliance on unreliable power sources, curbing carbon emissions and contributing to environmental conservation.

We have empowered schools to meet their energy needs independently, ensuring a steady energy supply for critical educational functions and enhancing the educational experience for over **2400 children.**

Project 2: School Readiness Program

The National Education Policy highlights the critical importance of early childhood education, recognizing that 85% of brain development occurs before age 6. Despite this, access to quality early childhood education remains a challenge, especially for socio-economically disadvantaged groups. The policy aims to ensure universal access to quality early childhood development, care, and education, preparing all students for Grade 1. TDPS, alongside partner Keyed Foundation, has launched the School Readiness Program to support this goal.

This program is designed to operate pre-primary classrooms in 20 government schools located in Anekal Block, Bengaluru Rural, with a total cost of Rs.10 lakhs. The primary objective is to enhance early childhood education in government schools that serve low-income communities.

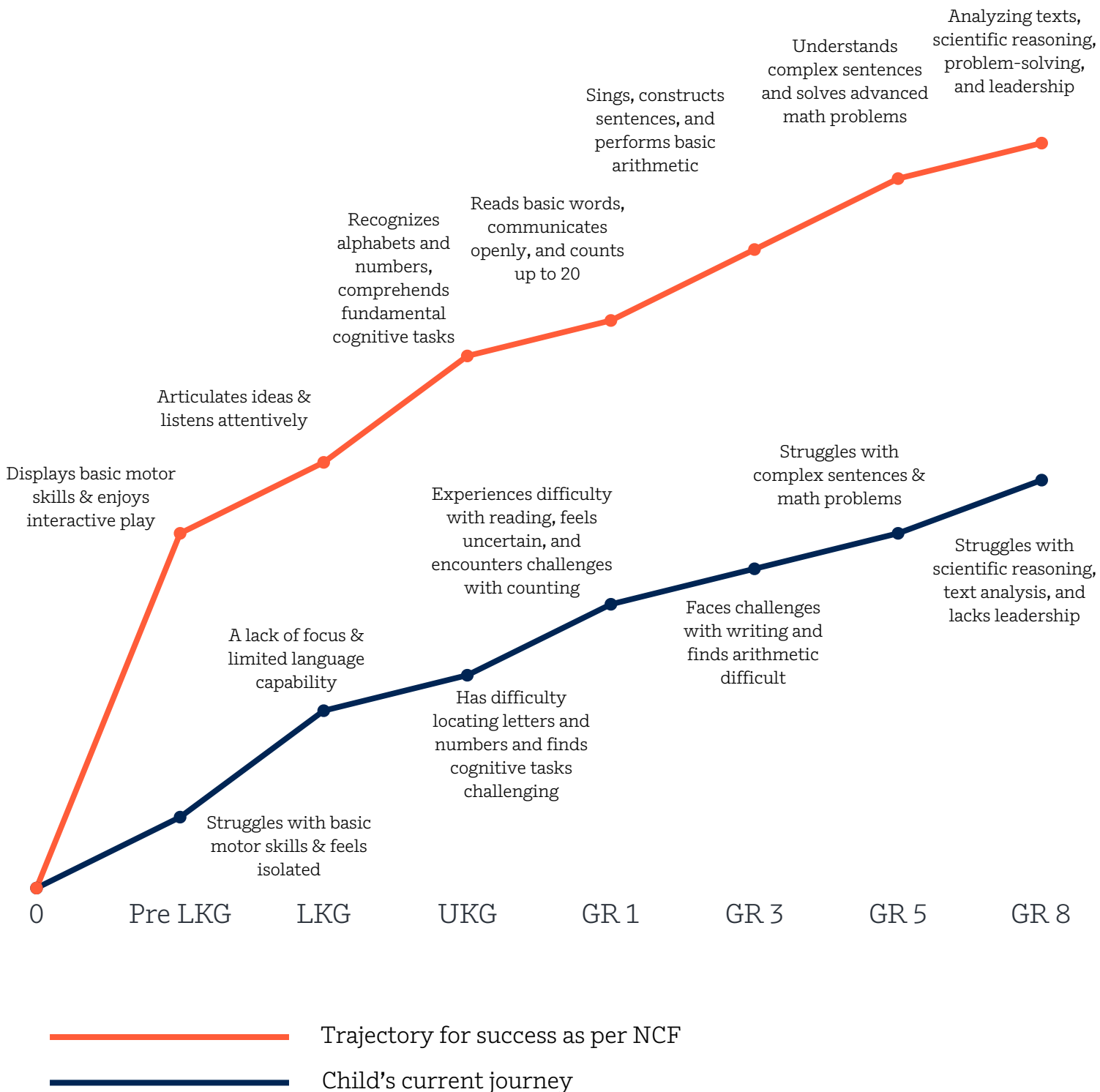
Additionally, this program offers a range of flexible, play-based learning activities such as alphabets, languages, numeracy, colors, shapes, indoor and outdoor play, puzzles, logical thinking, problem-solving, drawing, painting, visual arts, crafts, drama, puppetry, music, and movement. It also places significant emphasis on developing social skills, ethical values, personal hygiene, teamwork, and cooperation.

To support this initiative, we are equipping pre-primary classrooms with suitable curriculum materials and creating safe, stimulating learning environments. The project includes targeted training and coaching for teachers, workshops to involve parents in their child's education, and weekly worksheets. This effort is expected to benefit over 1000 children, parents, and teachers, laying a strong foundation for their educational journey.

Project 3: Rehabilitation and remedial support for children with learning disabilities

TDPS, in collaboration with its partner Spastics Society of Karnataka (SSK), has launched a project to provide rehabilitation and remedial support for children with various learning difficulties, including challenges in reading, writing, mathematics, visual and auditory processing disorders, ADHD, memory issues, and more. Diagnosis and intervention strategies are tailored to meet the specific needs of each child.

This initiative supports children with learning difficulties in 13 government schools in Harohalli, Bangalore Rural, with a total cost of Rs. 29.35 lakhs. Its primary goal is to prepare children for learning from preschool onward. Teachers refer students in grades I to VI with learning difficulties to the SSK-trained remedial team. An assessment determines the child's needs, followed by the development of an Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) and regular sessions with a dedicated remedial teacher to track progress.

Children in grades I to VI with learning difficulties and special needs are referred by their class teachers to the SSK-trained remedial team.

An informal assessment evaluates the child's performance, with formal assessments recommended as needed.

Subsequently, each child receives an Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) and is paired with a dedicated remedial teacher for regular sessions and progress reviews.

The duration of a child's remedial program within the project is typically 5-6 years, depending on when the child started receiving services.

The project aims to facilitate successful transitions for children into middle and higher grades by providing consistent and sustained remedial instruction.

The project consists of focused and intensive interventions tailored to the specific needs of children with learning difficulties.

It also involves need-based medical referrals to Primary Health Centers (PHCs) or networking hospitals, as well as teacher training aimed at improving teaching and learning outcomes.

In total, the initiative is expected to benefit **282 children** in supported schools, fostering an environment for their academic and personal development.

Healthcare

At TDPS, we are committed to making healthcare accessible and affordable for all. Through dedicated resources in the healthcare sector, we ensure that essential services reach everyone, regardless of financial constraints. Our mission is to enhance healthcare accessibility and affordability, serving the well-being of communities and individuals.

Project 1: Equipment Donation

To enhance diagnostics, patient management, and treatment infrastructure, TDPS partnered with Give Foundation and its affiliate, Doctors For You (DFY), to donate medical equipment to Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical College and Research Institute in Bangalore, Karnataka. The donation includes a C-Arm machine, two suction machines, and stretchers totaling Rs. 26.07 lakhs in value. This support benefitted 750 patients at the time of donation, and continues to address ongoing needs.

Project 2: Neuro Rehabilitation Center

TDPS, with its partner Bangalore Sanjayanagar Lions Charitable Trust (BSLC), played a vital role in establishing a Neuro Rehabilitation Centre in Vidyaranyapura, Bangalore. Essential equipment worth Rs.11.35 lakhs was donated.

The centre offers high-quality, affordable services to encourage long-term rehabilitation for individuals, facilitating their recovery and return to work.

The project also focuses on training neuro-rehabilitation therapists for effective centre operation and community impact.

This initiative aims to offer comprehensive services for patients with neurological conditions, particularly benefiting the lower-income group in Bangalore North.

Project 3: Fire Watch 101

TDPS and its partner Beyond Carlton launched Project Fire Watch 101, costing Rs. 7.71 Lakhs. The project aids individuals affected by fire disasters and major burn injuries, primarily at Victoria Hospital in Bangalore. Addressing challenges in India's burn care infrastructure, it ensures timely and high-quality medical treatment for burn victims, including emergency care, surgeries, and rehabilitation services.



Moreover, the project emphasizes not only immediate medical care but also crucial aspects such as counseling and rehabilitation services for the healing process. Fire Watch 101 focuses on improving the functional ability, mental well-being and social integration of burn victims.

The impact team will include patients, medical professionals, nursing staff, family members, and caregivers, ensuring comprehensive support for those affected by burn injuries.

Project 4: Medical Support At Manipal Hospital, Bangalore

TDPS allocated Rs.25 lakhs to support patients at Manipal Hospital in Bangalore, partnering with the Manipal Foundation. This aims to ease the financial burden for individuals, particularly those from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, suffering from life-threatening diseases. TDPS's financial support has helped patients of diverse ages and backgrounds, including BPL families, orphans, individuals with disabilities, those needing prolonged ICU stays, pediatric and transplant patients.

Project 5: Healthy India Mission

TDPS supported the Healthy India Mission with a budget of Rs.4.42 Lakhs, a project initiated by Dr. B Ramana Rao, a Bengaluru-based cardiologist and recipient of the prestigious Padma Shri award for his healthcare contributions.

This initiative includes a weekly medical camp called “The Village Clinic” held in T Begur village, Nelamangala. Rural patients receive free healthcare services, including treatment, healthcare equipment, and a complimentary mid-day meal.

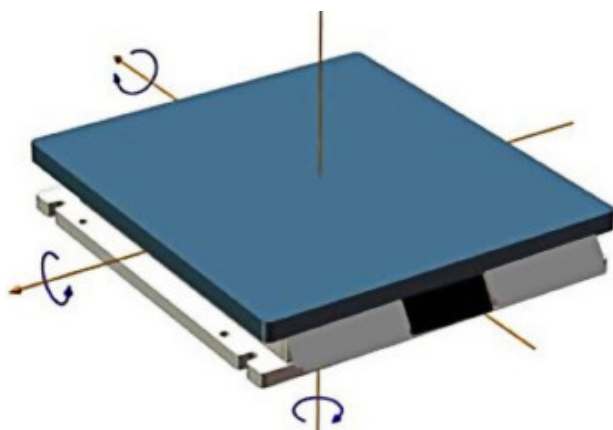
